



BUSINESS ACTION ITEM STAFF REPORT

ITEM . APPROVAL OF COST ESTIMATE TO PAINT A PROTECTIVE LAYER ON THE DISTRICT'S PIPE BRIDGE.

Summary:

The San Simeon Community Services District (“District”) asked Micah Rose (“Rose”), who works for the welding company that previously repaired the District’s pipe bridge, to provide an annual inspection of the pipe bridge. Rose identified work to be done that would extend the life of the pipe bridge another ten (10) years. Specifically, Rose recommended painting the pipe bridge to protect it from rust and other hazards.

The total cost estimate for the painting is Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000.00). Section 18.08.01 of the Policies and Procedures Governing the San Simeon Community Services District and Board of Directors (“Policies and Procedures”) requires all expenditures and purchases of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or greater to have prior authorization/approval by the District Board of Directors (“Board”). District staff request approval from the Board to proceed with painting the pipe bridge at a cost of Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000).

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board approve the Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000) cost estimate from Micah Rose to paint a protective layer on the District’s pipe bridge.
