The Consumer Confidence Report, or CCR, is an annual water quality report that the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) requires San Simeon Community Services District to provide to its consumers. The purpose of the CCR is to raise customers' awareness of the quality of their drinking water, where it comes from, what it takes to deliver it to their homes, and the importance of protecting drinking water sources.

On February 21, 2013, the California Department of Public Health expanded its interpretation of the SDWA to allow for electronic delivery of the CCR. The electronic delivery method will allow San Simeon Community Services District to reduce paper consumption and minimize potential printing and mailing costs.
