### Water Services Suring COVID-19

San Simeon Community Services District (SSCSD) wishes to reassure our water service customers that during the ongoing Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic staff continues the uninterrupted delivery of reliable, clean water for our residents and businesses. Our staff has been working diligently to continue to serve the community and maintain the water and wastewater facilities while adhering to state and county guidelines and practicing social distancing measures.

### District Area Surveillance Cameras

Due to the recent rise in graffiti-related crimes, the San Simeon Community Services District is considering installing surveillance cameras at key locations within the service area. Research shows that public surveillance camera systems can be a cost-effective way to deter, document, and reduce crime. ### Parking: RVs

If you have friends or family planning to visit San Simeon with their RV or trailer that will need to be parked on District streets, please remember that you must get a permit from the District Office. SSCSD Ordinance 107 details the RV parking permit requirements. We ask hotels that have patrons with RV's to park on hotel property or obtain a parking permit from the SSCSD if street parking is necessary. The parking permit is to keep tourists from camping on our streets. Please inform SSCSD Staff whenever you see an RV on District streets

that does not have a hot pink parking permit in the window. The permit should always be posted on the driver's side window. We thank you for your assistance in this matter.

### Water Conservation

Water conservation is a local, state, national and global issue. Most regions require water agencies to have a water conservation program in place. California has long been at the forefront of water conservation, becoming the first state to adopt urban water use efficiency targets with the Water Conservation Act of 2009.

## Equalization (EQ) Basin Cleaning and Repairs

The EQ basin is used to balance the flow of waste water into the treatment process. The EQ Basin is the first place wastewater enters so debris that's carried in the water settles at the bottom of the basin and occasionally needs to be removed. This year, in addition to cleaning the basin we replaced all of the deteriorated galvanized air lines with new air lines, which will improve the aeration of the wastewater in the EQ basin.
